1. Affidavit-of-service filed on behalf of the petitioner is taken on record.
2. Learned advocate representing the petitioner alleges harassment and threat at the instance of respondent nos.8 & 9 who are petitioner's son and daughter-in-law.
3. A complaint was lodged before the concerned police authority by the petitioner being senior citizen on 18th December, 2025.
4. It is disclosed in the said complaint dated 18th December, 2025 that on 30th November, 2025 petitioner was asked to appear before concerned officer of Kasba Police Station by a phone call. Petitioner complied with such request and reaching police station found his son and daughter-in-law

lodged a complaint against the petitioner.

5. It is also contended that in view of alleged ill-treatment petitioner is staying at the residence of her sister.
6. There are allegations of misappropriation of fund in connection with investments made by the husband of the petitioner.
7. Respondent nos.8 & 9 are represented by learned advocate who makes submission thereby disputing the case made out in this writ petition.
8. However, Mr. Das, learned Additional Government Pleader representing the State respondents prays for accommodation to file report.
9. Officer-in-Charge, Kasba Police Station, Kolkata being respondent no.7 is directed to cause an enquiry and file a report by fortnight from date.
10. The report to be filed by respondent no.7 shall disclose as to why petitioner was asked to attend Police Station on 30th November, 2025 without any notice.
11. Sub-Divisional Officer, Alipore (Sadar) respondent no.6 being the jurisdictional authority under the Maintenance and Welfare of Parents and Senior Citizens Act, 2007 is also directed to file a report, if necessary by causing an enquiry by three weeks from date.
12. Learned advocate for the petitioner is directed to

serve copy of the writ petition and order passed today upon the respondent no.6 by 19th June, 2026 and file affidavit-of-service on the next date.

13. List the matter under the same heading for further consideration on 15th July, 2026.
