police station.

4. Learned counsel for the State is directed to coordinate with the relevant authorities to ensure effective service and shall file a Formal Report regarding the status of such service on or before the next date of hearing.

5. The petitioner is further directed to serve a fresh copy of the notice, along with the complete set of pleadings, upon the learned counsel for the State to facilitate compliance with this order.

6. Let the matter be listed for further consideration on January 30, 2026.
