1. Affidavit of service filed by the petitioner is taken on record.
2. Mr. Yogeshwaran, learned counsel for the petitioner, Mr. Sahasrangshu Bhattacharya, learned counsel for the State, Mr. Alope Kumar Ghosh, learned counsel for the K.M.C. and Mr. Oishik Chatterjee, learned counsel for the private respondent, are heard on admission.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner by taking this court to Annexure P-3 submits

that the permission of construction appears to have been given only for 3 storeyed building, but illegally 6 storeyed building has been constructed.

4. Mr. Ghosh, learned counsel for the K.M.C. prays for and granted 4 weeks time to file a report by supplying an advance copy to the petitioner. In turn, petitioner may file exception within 2 weeks therefrom. The petitioner shall supply legible copy of petitioner and annexure to private respondent no.8 within two days. The private respondent may also file affidavit-in-opposition within 4 weeks. In turn, petitioner may file exception within 2 weeks therefrom. The private respondent is also at liberty to file exception to the report to be filed by the K.M.C.
5. List the matter after six weeks.
