Mr. Sudipta Dasgupta, learned Advocate appearing on behalf of the petitioners submit that the stay which was initially granted by the Hon'ble Supreme Court has not been extended subsequently and hence as of now there is no such stay existing against the order passed by the Hon'ble Division Bench in WPA 29606 of 2014.

2. Mr. Gourav Das, learned Advocate appearing on behalf of the District Primary School, South 24-Parganas informs this Court that though the order of stay has not been extended, however, the Hon'ble Supreme Court after being intimated by the learned Advocate for the State that they cannot accommodate petitioners the matter was released from the category of '*Part Heard*' and is placed for further hearing in the month of September, 2026 indicating that the matter will be heard on merit. He files a copy of the

order of the Hon'ble Supreme Court dated 25th May, 2026, which is taken on record.
