Learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is in custody for 3 years 9 months and till date, only 8 witnesses have been examined out of 67 witnesses cited in the charge-sheet and two of the witnesses have turned hostile.

However, more important is that a report should be submitted by the Investigating Officer of the case or a competent officer of the local police station detailing the antecedents of the present petitioner as also the grounds on which delay has taken place in course of the trial. Let such report be submitted before this Court on 18.06.2026.
