The petitioners are directed to serve copy of the revisional application along with the supplementary affidavit upon the opposite party no.1/State through the office of the learned Public Prosecutor, High Court, Calcutta and upon the opposite party no.2 by Speed Post with acknowledgement due and file affidavit-of-service on the next date fixed for hearing.

Learned advocate appearing for the petitioners has referred to affidavit-in-chief filed by the wife in Mat Suit No. 556 of 2021 and drawn the attention of the Court to paragraph 26 wherein it has been contended that the wife has been living separately from the husband since 01.03.2015. Learned advocate thereafter draws the attention of this Court to letter of complaint addressed to Inspector-in-Charge, Jagaddal Police Station which has referred to incidents of July, 2022.

Having considered the allegations in the FIR in the background of the evidence so deposed in the matrimonial suit, I am of the view that this revisional application is required to be heard out on merits.

Accordingly, list the revisional application under the heading “Contested Application” in the monthly list of August, 2024.

Liberty is granted to the petitioners to pray for interim order after filing certified copy of the affidavit-in-chief in Mat Suit No. 556 of 2021.

All concerned parties shall act on the server copy of this order duly downloaded from the official *website* of this Court.
