- 1) Affidavit of service filed on behalf of the petitioner is taken on record.
- 2) Matter is taken up for consideration in presence of learned advocates representing the petitioner, State respondents and respondent nos. 7 to 12.
- 3) Petitioner is a trust. By presenting this writ petition, petitioner has prayed for direction which would permit the petitioner to observe Maharam on land in question. It is submitted that for observing Maharam "No Objection" from the concerned police authority was prayed for but till date same has not

been granted prompting the petitioner to approach this Court with the present writ petition seeking direction upon the concerned police authority to take steps accordingly.

4) On behalf of respondent nos. 7 to 12 case made out in the writ petition is disputed since it is contended that land on which ritual is to be performed does not belong to the petitioner.

5) However, such submission made on behalf of the respondent nos. 7 to 12 is refuted on behalf of the petitioner on the strength of *ad interim* order dated 10th April, 2026 passed by the civil court in Title Suit No. 441 of 2026. It was directed by the civil court in order dated 10th April, 2026 that defendants were restrained from disturbing peaceful possession of the plaintiffs in the suit property. It is contended on behalf of the petitioner that respondent nos. 7 to 12 herein are defendants in Title Suit No. 441 of 2026. Therefore, order dated 10th April, 2026 binds respondent nos. 7 to 12.

6) Mr. Das, learned Additional Government Pleader prays for accommodation to obtain instruction.

7) Acceding to the request made on behalf of the State respondents, hearing of this matter stands adjourned.

8) List the matter under the same heading at the top on Monday next, 15th June, 2026.
