Mr. Ahammed, learned advocate appearing for the petitioners draws the attention of the Court to the eviction notice issued by the order of the authorities of the Eastern Railway which is annexed at page 41 of this writ petition in support of his contention that an absolutely vague notice has been issued by the authorities. He places reliance upon an order dated 19th May, 2026 passed in WPA 11040 of 2026 in the case of Sahidul Laskar Vs. The General Manager, Eastern Railway & Ors. in support of his contention that the Railway Authorities cannot evict the petitioners forcibly.

The learned advocate appearing for the Railways seeks time to take instructions in this matter.

It appears from the notice that the unauthorised occupants were requested to evict their position within 9th June, 2026 failing which action will be taken on the scheduled date as per the order of the competent authority.

To enable the learned advocate for the Railways to take instructions, list this matter tomorrow (10.06.2026) at 2 p.m.

Pending hearing of this writ petition no coercive steps shall be taken against the petitioners.
