1. Citing extreme urgency, this matter was mentioned yesterday. Upon obtaining leave for short service, the writ petition was filed and accordingly has been listed today. The parties are represented by their respective advocates.
2. By the writ petition, the writ petitioners seek to challenge the convening of a meeting by the Pradhan and the Upa-Pradhan on general affairs of the Gram Panchayat while the requisition for removal of the Pradhan and Upa-Pradhan is pending. A specific prayer has been made in the petition for a direction upon the concerned Block Development Officer (BDO) for convening a meeting on the issue of removal of Pradhan and Upa-Pradhan.
3. The Pradhan and Upa-Pradhan of Sirpur-I Gram Panchayat are represented by Mr. Jahan, learned advocate. He submits that two separate writ petitions being WPA 12123 of 2026 and WPA 12125 of 2026 have been filed by the Pradhan and the Upa-Pradhan respectively challenging the requisition notices. He submits that requisition is not in

accordance with law and as such no meeting for removal of the Pradhan and Upa-Pradhan is permissible on the basis of such requisition notices. He submits that on the writ petition being moved before the vacation Bench, this Hon'ble Court was pleased to entertain the same and place this matter before the regular Bench by observing that the steps taken in the meeting shall abide by the final result of the writ petition and the resolution if any, arrived at by virtue of the meeting shall not be given effect to without the leave of the Court. It is still further submitted that the meeting as scheduled did not take steps for diverse reasons.

4. The petitioners in the present writ petition has, however, filed a supplementary affidavit upon obtaining prior leave to bring on record, the steps taken by the Pradhan and Upa-Pradhan to hold a general meeting pending the requisition notices.
5. The state is represented by the learned Government Pleader.
6. Having heard the learned advocates appearing for the respective parties, I am of the view that the writ petition being WPA 12123 of 2026 and WPA 12125 of 2026 should be tagged along with this writ petition and heard together.
7. Considering the peculiar facts and the urgency involved, the State is directed to produce the records especially in relation to the requisition notices before this Court when the matter is taken up next.
8. List this matter tomorrow, i.e., 10<sup>th</sup> June, 2026 at 2 p.m.
9. Pending further consideration or till tomorrow whichever is earlier, no further meeting shall be convened by the

Pradhan and Upa-Pradhan or conducted in relation to the affairs of the Gram Panchayat.
