1. The petitioners herein have prayed for quashing of proceeding being G.R. Case No. 866/2026 under Sections 85/115(2)/351(2)/3(5) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 presently pending before learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Haldia.
2. Being aggrieved by the instant proceeding, learned Counsel for the petitioners submits that on perusal of the complaint it is apparent that there are no specific allegations against the petitioners and the instant case has been maliciously instituted due to gross misunderstanding wherein the petitioners were wrongly implicated. However, learned Counsel appearing on behalf of the opposite party and learned Counsel appearing for the petitioners submit that dispute between the parties is basically matrimonial

and private in nature and they have amicably settled the disputes at the intervention of the well wisher and friends. Therefore, learned Counsel appearing on behalf of the de facto complainant/opposite party, on instruction, submits that his client does not want to proceed further with the criminal proceeding in view of amicable settlement arrived at by and between the parties. Therefore, learned Counsel appearing for both opposite party no. 2 and petitioners submit that further continuance of the impugned proceeding in view of amicable settlement would be mere abuse of the process of the Court. They further seek leave to file a connected application recording amicable settlement.

3. Having heard learned Counsel for the petitioners, the application is admitted.
4. Petitioners are directed to serve a copy of application upon the State through the office of the learned Public Prosecutor, High Court, Calcutta who will bring the case diary on the next date.
5. Let the matter be listed under the heading 'To Be Mentioned' on 25th June, 2026.
6. Parties will be at liberty to file connected application, if any, in the meantime.
