1. Receipt showing payment of deficit court fees filed in Court be taken on record.
2. As many as sixteen petitioners in this writ petition allege that they are retired employee of the jute mills, and that certain amount is due and payable to them. Details of the amount allegedly due are disclosed in paragraphs 21 and 22 of the writ petition.
3. The third respondent – Regional Provident Fund Commissioner, Employees Provident Fund Organization Regional Office, Kolkata – is directed to revert with a written report pertaining to the allegation of the writ petitioners.
4. The report shall specifically disclose whether any amount is due and payable to the petitioners, as claimed.
5. Let a copy of the report be prepared and circulated by July 17, 2026.
6. Relist the matter on July 24, 2026.
7. It will be open for the petitioners to file exception to the report prior to the returnable date.

8. All parties are to act on the server copy of this order duly downloaded from the official website of this Court.
9. Certified copy of this order, if applied for, shall be made available to the parties.
