1. Report filed on behalf of the State be kept with the record.
2. Heard the submissions by the learned counsel appearing for the petitioners.
3. At this stage, on the prayer of the learned counsel for the petitioners for further hearing of the matter is adjourned till 6th March, 2026 under the same heading.
4. Learned counsel appearing for the State submits that previous report whereby it transpires that the investigation has been completed and on the verge of submitting a final report against the accused person but because of the interim order passed by this Court, not to take any coercive steps against the present petitioners, he is hesitating to file the same.

5. It is made clear pendency of the application or the interim order so granted will not debar the Investigating Authority to submit a report in a final form, if any.
6. The interim order granted earlier, which is in force till 15th February, 2026, be extended till 31st March, 2026 or until further orders, whichever is earlier.
