1. The petitioners have filed the present writ application being dissatisfied with the description of the terms and conditions of the schedule of the tender notice dated May 21, 2026 with regard to the upgradation of toilets in non-AC LHB coaches for a total number of 240 numbers of coaches against sanction bulk RSP work vide PB No. 320/2024-25 and 330/2025-26 at carriage complex, Kanchapara within a period of eighteen months.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners are also the manufacturer of Thermoformable Decorative Polymerized Composite Panel (TDPCP) but the respondent authorities have only chosen to accept the tender of Kommerling, Aluplast and Alstone.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioners has relied upon the circular issued by the Government of India, Ministry of Railways dated August 3, 2017 wherein the Government has taken a decision for procurement of the materials of make in India and further by an order dated June 15, 2017, issued instructions that preference shall be given

to local suppliers in all procurements undertaken by procuring entities in the manner specified in the said order.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the respondent authorities in the said tender have directed to supply the make of Kommerling, AIuplast and Alstone out of which two companies are the German Company and have not given the preference to the Indian Company in terms of the circular issued by the Government of India, Ministry of Railways.
5. Learned counsel for the respondent authorities prays for time to take proper instruction.
6. This Court finds that the closing date of tender is June 12, 2026 at 2.00 p.m. Considering the submission made by the learned counsel for the petitioners and perusing the documents, this Court finds that the petitioners have made out an arguable case and the respondents have to clarify before this Court why the authorities have issued the tender for supply the materials only three companies out of which two companies are the foreign companies. Learned counsel for the respondent authorities prays for fixing the matter on June 16, 2026.
7. Let the matter appear on June 16, 2026 at the top under the same heading. In the meantime, the authorities have directed not to finalize the technical bid till the further order.
