1. Parties are represented.
2. Mr. Dutta, learned advocate appears for the writ petitioner has placed contention and prayer of the petitioner in an application being CAN 6 of 2026.
3. According to him, inter alia, the respondents have been constructing unauthorizedly and illegally over the premises which originally belonged to the petitioner i.e. comprised of in place of Plot No. 253/459.

4. It has further been submitted that firstly the sanctioned plan which the respondents intend to rely on is in contravention of provisions of law and illegally. Secondly, that the sanction has been granted by the authorities for making construction in Ward No.20 whereas construction has been made by the concerned respondents in Ward No. 10 in place of Ward No. 21 in absolute violation of the sanctioned plan granted in his favour.
5. Mr. Kankani, learned advocate appearing for the respondent no. 10 seeks leave to file an affidavit-in-opposition as regards petitioner's application being CAN No. 6 of 2026.
6. Let affidavit-in-opposition be filed by respondent no.10 as regards application being CAN 6 of 2026 within a period of ten days from today.
7. Petitioner may file affidavit-in-reply within three days thereafter.
8. Let this matter come up in the list from the date of sitting of this Court after two weeks marked at 2.00 P.M.
