1. Learned senior counsel for the petitioner has invited the attention of the Court to the latest medical report dated 8th July, 2025 received from Apollo Hospitals being signed by Dr. Sisir Das, MS (Neurology) Surgery which inter alia states that :

“With consideration of his pre-diagnosed Parkinsonism and spino cerebellar ataxia, he has witnessed substantial cognitive decline coupled with loss of consciousness and motor function deterioration. He is unable to walk without support and suffers from recurrent spell of dizziness. After considering his age and incurable nature of spino-cerebellar ataxia there is no likelihood

of any improvement in his health which continues to deteriorate as the disease progress.”

2. Let this report be brought on record.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner insists for grant of bail to the petitioner on medical ground. Learned counsel submits that the latest report indicates that the petitioner is sick.

4. Learned counsel for the ED has opposed the prayer.

5. Learned counsel for ED has also placed on record affidavit-in-opposition. Let it be taken on record as copy has already been supplied to the petitioner.

6. The Court considers that before proceeding further, let IPGMER and SSKM Centre of Excellence, Bangur Institute of Neurosciences, department of Health and Family Welfare. Government of West Bengal constitute a Board of senior doctors including Neurosurgeon, Cardiologist, Cardio physician and General Physician. The medical superintendent may consider making the head of the departments of this departments as the member of the Board. Medical superintendent may also add any other specialist also taking into account the medical reports and health condition of the petitioner.

7. In view of the health condition of the petitioner, as prima facie, reflected from the medical report, the Board so constituted is requested to visit the Apollo Hospital and examine the patient with assistance of the treating doctors at Apollo Hospital. Apollo Hospital shall render all possible assistance to the Board so

constituted. The expenses, if any, which incurred in conducting such examination and preparing the report shall be borne by the petitioner.

8. The Board shall submit its report within one week with copy to the order be sent to the medical Superintendent, IPGMER and SSKM Centre of Excellence. Copy of the report be given in advance to the learned counsel for the petitioner and the Enforcement Directorate.

9. Let the matter be listed on 7th August, 2025 at 12.00 p.m.
