- 1.** All the present applications have been moved for extension of interim order. Learned counsel submits that the extension applications were moved before expiry of the interim order.
- 2.** Affidavit of service has been filed, let it be taken on record.
- 3.** Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the appellate court dismissed the appeal solely on the ground that

the petitioner did not comply with the order of deposit of 20% of the cheque amount in terms of Section 143A of the Negotiable Instruments Act. Learned counsel submits that the order passed by the appellate court is erroneous.

4. Per contra, learned counsel for the respondent submits that it is the second round of litigation. In the first round, the appellate court had directed to deposit 20% of the cheque amount which was challenged before this court. This court reduced the amount to 10% and the revisional application kept pending. Learned counsel submits, however, the appellant even did not deposit with 10% amount and thus the appellate court dismissed the appeal.

5. Let both the parties file the written notes of argument not exceeding five pages with a copy to the other parties.

6. In the meantime, interim order is extended till 24th December, 2025 or until further orders, whichever is earlier.

7. Accordingly, applications being CRAN 3 of 2025 in CRR 2532 of 2025, CRAN 3 of 2025 in CRR 2533 of 2025 and CRAN 3 of 2025 in CRR 2534 of 2025 stands disposed of.

8. Let the matter be listed on 16th December, 2025 at 2.30 p.m.
