Affidavit of service filed in Court is taken on record.

Mr. Bhattacharjee, learned Senior Counsel appears
for the petitioners.

Mr. Nag, learned Senior Counsel representing the
Port Trust Authorities, submits that there is gross suppression
of material facts in this writ petition. He submits that an order
has been passed by the West Bengal Pollution Control Board
issuing directions upon the electricity authorities to
disconnect the supply of electricity to the premises in
question and the police authorities have also been requested
by the Pollution Control Board to render necessary assistance
to the respective authorities in this regard. He further submits
that eviction proceeding under the provision of the Public
Premises (Eviction of Unauthorized Occupants) Act, 1971 has
been initiated which culminated into eviction orders passed
by the Estate Officer. Some of such eviction orders have been
carried in appeal and excepting in one of such appeals, there
is no subsisting order of injunction.

Faced with such situation, Mr. Bhattacharjee, learned
Senior Counsel appearing for the petitioners seeks time to

take instructions in this regard.

Mr. Nag assures this Court that the particulars of the orders passed by the Pollution Control Board, Estate Officers as well as the Appellate Authority shall be furnished to the learned Advocate-on-Record for the petitioners by 22nd June, 2026.
