1. Leave is granted to the petitioners to file the supplementary affidavit in Court today annexing necessary documents for adjudication.
2. Memo No.185-CS/2026 followed by Order No.189/2026 both dated June 14, 2026 passed by the Chief Secretary, Government of West Bengal are impugned in the instant writ petition.
3. It is submitted by the learned senior advocate for the petitioners that such mandatory direction cannot be passed upon the employees of the State Government. According to him, legislation does not provide such a mandate to be issued.
4. Learned Additional Advocate General appearing for the State seeks time to revert with instructions.
5. In view of such submission, relist the matter tomorrow – June 19, 2026.
