Petitioners are directed to serve a copy of the revisional application upon the opposite party no.1/State through the office of the learned Public Prosecutor, High Court, Calcutta and upon the opposite party no.2 by speed post with acknowledgement due and file affidavit-of-service on the next date fixed for hearing.

Mr. Ganguly, learned senior advocate appearing for the petitioners referred to the relevant paragraphs of the letter of complaint which has been treated to be the First Information Report of the instant case and submitted that admittedly the contractual obligations were discharged by the petitioner-company and in spite of the same, the responsible officers are being harassed by the investigating agency of Karaya Police Station.

I have considered the allegations made in the FIR. Prima facie, I find that a case has been made out for hearing as the issues have their genesis on a contractual agreement and admittedly in the complaint, two of the consignments were completed by the petitioner no.1.

Accordingly, let the revisional application appear under the heading “Contested Application” in the monthly list of August, 2024.

Pending hearing of the revisional application, further proceedings of Karaya Police Station Case No.265 dated 10.10.2023 before the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Alipore be stayed till 31st August, 2024.

State is directed to produce the case diary on the next date so fixed for hearing.
