1. The petitioner herein has prayed for quashing of charge-sheet no. 397 dated 23.12.2024 corresponding to Ghola Police Station Case No. 360 dated 23.11.2024. It is submitted that petitioner is a septuagenarian citizen and has been falsely entangled with the instant proceeding. He further submits that a counter F.I.R. has also been lodged by the petitioner herein being Ghola Police Station Case No. 361/2024 dated 23.11.2024. However, petitioner submits that during the bail prayer made by the petitioner, opposite party filed an affidavit before the Trial Court wherein she has disclosed that out of misunderstanding she has initiated the proceeding and if the petitioner is released on bail she has got no objection. Learned Counsel

for the petitioner submits that the purport of her averment intimates a document that the instant case is nothing but a malicious prosecution cloaked as a counter-case having taken the advantage of helplessness of a septuagenarian gentleman. Therefore, further continuance of the impugned proceeding would be mere abuse of the process of the Court. He, therefore, prayed for quashing of the proceeding which is a result of sheer misunderstanding.

2. Having heard learned Counsel for the petitioner, the application stands admitted.
3. Mr. Imran Siddiqui, who is a State panel lawyer, is hereby appointed to represent the State. Petitioner has already served a copy of application upon Mr. Siddiqui. Petitioner shall serve a copy of application upon the de facto complainant/opposite party no. 2 through speed post intimating next date of hearing and to file affidavit-of-service on the returnable date.
4. Let the matter be listed on 29th June, 2026.
5. State shall produce the case diary along with a report on the date fixed.
