On the prayer of Mr. Malay Dhar, learned advocate appearing for the petitioners, the counter affidavit to the compliance affidavit filed by the alleged contemnors filed in Court today is taken on record.

The order dated **January 30, 2026** passed in the matter speaks in detail.

Though the Rule was issued but was kept in abeyance since some payments were made to the petitioners.

Today, Mr. Malay Dhar, learned advocate appearing for the petitioners submits that, the payments made are also not in accordance with the salary structure of the petitioners which they had been paid previously, despite having no change in the salary structure till date.

Be that as it may, Mr. Samrat Mukherji, learned Additional Government Pleader appearing for the

contemnors has filed a detail statement with supportive documents signed by the alleged contemnor dated July 20, 2026, the same is taken on record. The alleged contemnor shall file an affidavit enclosing this bunch of documents in the affidavit and serve a copy of such affidavit upon the learned advocate on record for the petitioners.

The petitioners shall be at liberty to file a counter affidavit thereto.

Such affidavit shall be filed by the alleged contemnor on or before August 10, 2026. Counter thereto shall be filed by the petitioners on or before August 24, 2026.

The matter shall appear under the heading **“Contempt Application”** on **September 11, 2026**.

Pendency of this contempt proceeding shall not preclude the alleged contemnors to revisit the issue on the basis of the available records and if necessary, with the assistance of the petitioners in the meantime and then to take steps in accordance with law for payment to the petitioners and inform this Court on the next day by filing a compliance report.

However, it is also made clear that, this direction has been passed without prejudice to the rights and contentions of the parties in the contempt proceeding.
