Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is a road contractor having valid license and on the basis of a work order issued in his favour for construction of road from Chandipur to Ghoramutdha (upto Gholda) within Chandipur Panchayat samity, he started the work but was unable to continue with the same as the public health engineering department started installing pipe lines on the said road which caused damage to the road. The petitioner has resumed the said work and has completed major portion of the work. No payment has been made to him for the same.

The State is directed to submit a report responding to the contention of the petitioner in the writ petition.

Let the matter appear under the same heading on 23rd July, 2026.
