This application under Article 227 of the Constitution of India is at the instance of the plaintiff praying for a direction upon the Learned Civil Judge (Senior Division), 2nd Court at Barasat, North 24 Parganas to dispose of Title Suit No. 1001 of 2023 expeditiously.

The learned Advocate appearing for the petitioner submits that the suit is at the peremptory hearing stage. 18th September, 2026 is the date for peremptory hearing.
