1. The petitioner is pursuing B.A. Psychology from the West Bengal State University. She is aggrieved as the university has not issued the mark-sheet of her Sixth Semester Examination conducted in June 2025.
2. Prayer has been made to direct the university to publish her mark-sheet.
3. Learned counsel for the university submits, upon instructions, that the result of the petitioner has been withheld as she did not clear her backlog English Examination which was held on January 2, 2026.
4. According to the university, it has obtained instructions by a communication dated July 8, 2026 from the Principal of Acharya Prafulla Chandra College, North 24 Parganas, where the petitioner was due to appear on January 2, 2026, that the candidate did not appear in the English

Examination held on January 2, 2026; and that the candidate was marked 'absent' in the DR sheet duly signed by the invigilators.

5. To this, the petitioner appearing in person insists that she did appear in the examination in Acharya Prafulla Chandra College centre on January 2, 2026.
6. As the college is not a party in the instant litigation, the Court cannot ascertain the facts directly from the college.
7. Leave is, therefore, granted to the petitioner to implead the college as party respondent in the instant writ petition and serve a copy of the writ petition upon the college authority communicating this order.
8. Relist the matter for further consideration on July 22, 2026.
9. As directed, the university has handed over the mark-sheet of the Sixth Semester Examination to the petitioner in Court. A copy of the same be retained with the records of the case.
10. It appears from the mark-sheet that the petitioner has cleared the Sixth Semester Examination 2025.
11. Acharya Prafulla Chandra College authority shall produce all relevant records in original in respect of the candidate to show whether the petitioner appeared in the backlog English Examination from the centre on January 2, 2026 or not. The attendance sheet, in original, of all the candidates who appeared in the examination on January 2, 2026 shall be placed before the Court.
12. All parties are to act on the server copy of this order duly downloaded from the official website of this court.

13. Certified copy of this order, if applied for, shall be made available to the parties.
