An objection has been raised by the learned advocate appearing for the State against the filing of a joint writ petition.

Faced with such submission, the learned advocate appearing for the petitioners prays for leave to deposit the deficit court fees on or before the next date of hearing.

Petitioners will be at liberty to put in the deficit court fees on or before the next date of hearing.

In the light of such assurance given by the learned advocate for the petitioner the writ petition is taken up for consideration.

The petitioners claim to be running business on the platform at Parkcircus Railway Station. The petitioners allege that the railway authorities have threatened to evict the petitioners from the portion of the platform where they are in occupation.

The learned advocate for the petitioner submits that a notice of eviction has also been issued by the railway authorities.

The learned advocate appearing for the State submits that similar matters have been fixed for hearing on June 29, 2026.

Let a report be filed by the Divisional Railway Manager, Sealdah Division, Eastern Railway, being the respondent no.3 on or before next date of hearing.

A batch of writ petitions involving identical questions of law and fact is pending and the hearing in the aforesaid batch have already commenced. In the said batch of writ petitions an interim order has already been passed for a limited period.

For such reason, this Court is inclined to pass an interim order.

The Railway Authorities are restrained from taking any coercive steps against the petitioners till the end of the month of June, 2026 or until further orders, whichever is earlier.

List this matter on June 29, 2026 along with other similar matters.
