1. With consent of the parties matter is heard on being assigned by the Hon'ble the Acting Chief Justice vide order dated 1st July, 2026.
2. During course of hearing Mr. Ayan Bhattacharjee, learned senior advocate representing petitioner prays for leave to withdraw the Criminal Revisional Application

being CRR No. 2583 of 2026 in consideration of the order passed by this Court on the writ petition being WPA 11489 of 2026 (Abhishek Banerjee vs. The State of West Bengal & Ors.) on 21st May, 2026.

3. In the same breath, prayer is made for giving direction upon the police authorities which would prevent the mob from egg pelting at the time of complying with the order/notice of jurisdictional Magistrate/investigating agency by appearing before the appropriate authority for the sake of investigation.
4. Having considered the submission made on behalf of the petitioner Criminal Revisional Application being CRR 2583 of 2026 is dismissed as withdrawn.
5. Petitioner is directed to comply with the order passed by this Court on 21st May, 2026 on the writ petition being WPA 11489 of 2026.
6. However, police authorities are directed to take measures so that petitioner will not be victim of egg pelting or any other harassment when petitioner will appear before the jurisdictional Magistrate/investigating agency for complying notices. Petitioner shall appear before the jurisdictional Magistrate for recording of voice sample on 15th July, 2026 at 12.00 noon.
