1. Let affidavit-of-service, as filed in Court, be kept on record.
2. In spite of service, the private respondent is not represented.
3. As it appears from the records, the private respondent, co-owner of the property, objected to electricity connection to be given to the petitioner's premises.
4. The reason for such objection given by the private respondent is not clear as there is no disruption to the connection given to the private respondent or to his property.
5. Mr. Bandyopadhyay, learned Advocate appearing for the West Bengal State Electricity Distribution Company Limited, submits that while giving

electricity connection, the poles and the wires may pass through a common area, which is causing apprehension to the private respondent along with other co-owners who have not been arrayed as party respondents herein.

6. Respondent no. 3 is directed to cause an inspection and file a report to indicate whether the poles and wires can be installed and pass through an alternative route to enable the petitioner to get electricity connection at his premises.

7. Let such report be filed by July 21, 2026.

8. List this matter before the appropriate Bench on July 23, 2026 subject to His Lordship's convenience.
