Heard learned Advocates appearing for the parties.

Pursuant to the earlier direction of this court dated 6th September, 2023, learned Advocate appearing for the respondents/Electricity authority concerned has submitted inspection report relating to the premises in question as to whether the petitioner resides therein or not and on perusal of which it appears prima facie that petitioner does not reside at the premises in question for which petitioner has asked for relief of shifting of electricity meter. Let such report be kept with the record and a copy of the same be handed over to the learned Advocates appearing for the petitioner and the private respondents.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case I find that there is no scope of passing any interim order in the matter and the issues involve

require affidavit from the respondents for final adjudication.

Respondents are directed to file affidavit-in-opposition within four weeks. Petitioner to file reply thereto, if any, within two weeks thereafter.

List this matter for final hearing in the monthly list of December, 2023.

At the time of hearing, parties should be ready with the short written notes of arguments.
