The order dated 1st July, 2026 passed the Estate Officer, Syama Prasad Mookerjee Port, Kolkata in a proceeding being No. 2235/D of 2026 is under challenge in the civil revisional application. It has been specifically stated in paragraph 13 of the civil revisional application that the matter was fixed before the Estate Officer on 1st July, 2026 at 3 p.m. but the Estate Officer commenced the proceeding at about 11 a.m. on the said date.

The learned advocate appearing for the petitioner draws the attention of the Court to page 51 of the civil revisional application i.e. the daily attendance sheet in support of such contention.

It prima facie appears to this Court that an effective opportunity has not been provided to the petitioner.

For such reason, this Court is inclined to pass an interim order.

There shall be an order of stay of all further proceeding being No. 2235/D of 2026 pending before the Estate Officer including delivery of judgement till the end of the month of August, 2026 or until further orders whichever is earlier.

At this stage Mr. Nag, learned advocate appears for the opposite party and submits that he has instructions to appear in this matter.

Let a copy of the civil revisional application be served upon the junior of Mr. Nag, learned advocate for the opposite party.

List this matter in the Monthly List of August, 2026 under the heading "Motion".
