CAN 1 of 2026

This is an application seeking extension of time in complying with the order dated 6 April, 2026.

It is submitted on behalf of the applicant Union of India that the time to comply with the order dated 6 April, 2026 be extended in view of the fact that the respective Departments have been unable to carry out the directions contained in the order.

By an order dated 6 April, 2026, this Court had, *inter alia*, directed as follows:

“In view of the submissions made on behalf of the parties, all these writ petitions are disposed of by directing the Civil Aviation Department, Government of India, Department of Pension and Pensions Welfare (DoPPW) and the AAI to take a final decision insofar as the grievance of the petitioners are concerned within a period of three months from the date of communication of this order.”

On behalf of the writ petitioner, it is fairly submitted that they have no objection if the time to take a final

decision in terms of the order dated 6 April, 2026 is extended.

In view of the submissions made on behalf of the parties, CAN 1 of 2026 stands allowed by extending the time to implement the order dated 6 April, 2026 by a further period of four months from date.

With the above directions, CAN 1 of 2026 stands disposed of.
