The grievance of the petitioner in all these matters is directed against non-payment of pension under the Central Pension Scheme.

By an ad interim order dated July 18, 2023, it was categorically recorded on behalf of the Airport Authority of India, being the respondent Nos. 1 to 4, that the pensionary benefits of the petitioner have been processed and the same have to be disbursed by the Central Government.

The Union of India is represented and prays for an opportunity to take instructions in these matters.

Liberty is granted to the Union of India to file a Report in the form of an affidavit, if so advised.

Let these matters appear for further hearing on September 19, 2024 in order to enable the Union of India to take positive instructions in these matters.
