1. Affidavit of service filed today be kept on record.
2. It is rightly pointed out by learned counsel for the writ petitioners in WPA 15590 of 2022 that the said writ petition ought not to have featured in paragraph 17 of the judgment of this court dated September 18, 2025.
3. Accordingly, let the expression "WPA 15590 of 2022" stand deleted from paragraph 17 of the said order dated September 18, 2025.
4. Learned counsel for the said writ petitioners further submits that the writ petitioners apprehend that as the court has observed in paragraph 25 of the

said order that the writ petitioners have already applied for disconnection and the DVC would be at liberty to disconnect the electricity supply of the petitioners subject to adjustment of total outstanding dues and as the petitioners want to migrate to some other distribution company and prior to such migration, if the disconnection is effected, the writ petitioners will be in jeopardy, the said observation in the order be altered.

5. Learned counsel for the DVC submits that in the event the writ petitioners in WPA 15590 of 2022 go on paying electricity charges regularly, there is no question of such disconnection being effected, unless the writ petitioners want so. In any event, unless there is a disconnection of power supply by the DVC, there would not arise any occasion for the writ petitioners to migrate/shift to some other distribution company. Hence, an application had to be filed for disconnection in order for the writ petitioners to migrate to some other distribution company. Therefore, I do not find any reason to alter the observations made in paragraph 25 of the said order. This order be deemed to be a part of the order dated September 18, 2025.
