1. Affidavit of service filed on behalf of the petitioner is taken on record.
2. Learned advocate representing petitioner submits that he is tenant of premises no. 217, NSC Bose Road under Netaji Nagar Police Station, Kolkata. However, respondent no. 6 being landlady is not giving access to the representatives of CESC to inspect electric meter and to carry out necessary work as a result whereof supply of electricity to the shop of the petitioner is being impacted.
3. Learned advocate representing respondent no. 6 on instruction submits that respondent no. 6 has no objection, if electric meter is

inspected and necessary work is carried out by the representatives of CESC.

4. However, learned advocate representing CESC submits that previously attempt was made to carry out work and inspect electric meter of the petitioner but access was not provided by the respondent no. 6.
5. State respondents are represented by learned advocate.
6. Respondent no. 6 is directed to permit representatives of CESC to inspect electric meter and carry out necessary work on 04th August, 2026 when representatives of CESC shall go to the premises of the petitioner at 12.00 noon.
7. Officer-in-Charge, Netaji Nagar Police Station, Kolkata being respondent no. 4 is directed to provide necessary assistance for carrying out direction passed today.
8. Officer-in-Charge, Netaji Nagar Police Station as well as concerned authority of CESC are directed to submit report on the next date.
9. List the matter under the heading 'New Motion-1' on 18th August, 2026.
