Mr. Bapin Baidya, learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits that, in so far as alleged contemnor no. 1 is concerned, he has complied with the direction of this Court dated **March 17, 2025**.

The alleged contemnor no. 2 has also partly complied but the rest of the compliance shall be done in a short while as the petitioner has been informed by the alleged contemnor no. 2.

However, neither the contemnors appear nor they are represented.

It is noted that no affidavit of service has been filed today.

On the basis of the submissions made on behalf of the petitioner and since the alleged contemnor no. 1 has complied with the direction, this contempt proceeding **CPAN 1275 of 2025** stands **dropped** and **closed** against **alleged contemnor no. 1**.

The contempt proceeding shall remain pending and shall survive as against the alleged contemnor no. 2 so long the direction is not complied with.

The petitioner shall serve a copy of today's order upon both the alleged contemnors and shall file an affidavit of service when the matter shall appear next.

The proceeding shall appear under the heading **“Contempt Application”** on **January 9, 2026**.

Pendency of this contempt proceeding shall not preclude the alleged contemnor no. 2 to comply with the direction of this Court totally and to file a compliance report on the next day.
