There is substance in the argument of the learned advocate appearing for the petitioners that an application for amendment filed on November 6, 2024 challenging a deed of gift, may be said to be barred by law in view of the averments made in the original plaint presented sometimes in the month of April, 2021.

By the order impugned, the application under Order 6 Rule 17 of the Civil Procedure Code praying for amendment of the plaint, stood allowed.

Petitioners are directed to serve a copy of this application upon the opposite party by registered speed post with acknowledgement due and file an affidavit of service on the next date.

There shall be an order of stay of all further proceedings in Title Suit No. 135 of 2021 pending

before the learned Civil Judge (Sr. Division), 2nd Additional Court, Purba Burdwan till the end of the month of December, 2025 or until further order whichever is earlier.
