1. This revisional application has been preferred seeking the quashing of Katwa Police Station Case No. 872 of 2024 dated 08.10.2024 under Sections 406/420 of the Indian Penal Code, corresponding to G.R. Case No. 1344 of 2024.
2. Ms. Banerjee, learned Advocate representing the petitioner, submits that to discharge certain liabilities, opposite party No. 2 issued three cheques in favour of the petitioner. The petitioner presented those cheques to the bank; however, due to insufficiency of funds in the account of opposite party No. 2, the cheques were not honoured. Faced with this situation, the petitioner was compelled to lodge three complaints against opposite party No. 2. However, opposite party No. 2, to save himself, lodged a complaint against the petitioner almost after one year, alleging that the petitioner forged his signature and fraudulently obtained those cheques. He submits that if this case is allowed to continue, it would amount to an abuse of the due process of law.
3. Having heard the learned Advocate appearing for the petitioner and upon perusal of the materials on record, I am of the view that the issue raised by the petitioner in the present revisional application

requires consideration on merits, and that the petitioner has made out a good arguable case.

4. In view thereof, all further proceedings in Katwa Police Station Case No. 872 of 2024 dated 08.10.2024 under Sections 406/ 420 of the Indian Penal Code, corresponding to G.R. Case No. 1344 of 2024, shall be stayed until the end of November 2025 or until further orders, whichever is earlier.

5. The petitioner is directed to serve a copy of this revisional application, along with all annexures thereto, upon the opposite parties, together with a notice intimating that the matter shall be taken up for further consideration on 18th November 2025, and to file an affidavit of service on the returnable date.

6. List the matter for further consideration on 18th November, 2025.
