1. Affidavit-of-service filed on behalf of petitioners is taken on record.
2. Matter is heard in presence of the learned advocates representing petitioners and State respondents.
3. At the threshold Mr. Sabyasachi Chatterjee, learned advocate representing petitioners has filed a document in support of putting in deficit court fees and same is taken on record.
4. Grievance of the petitioners is common, that is, post declaration of result of General Assembly Election, 2026 on 4th May, 2026 petitioners are unable to stay at their residences due to alleged political violence. Petitioners have made a common prayer to direct the concerned police authority to take steps which would enable them to return back to their respective residence and lead life peacefully.
5. Having considered the case made out in this writ petition it is found that all the petitioners are residents of Birbhum district and they shall be at liberty to make representation individually before the Inspector-in-Charge/ Officer-in-Charge of concerned

police station under which petitioners reside by seven (7) days from date seeking assistance.

6. If concerned Inspector-in-Charge/ Officer-in-Charge of respective police station receive such representations, necessary assistance shall be provided to petitioners in order to enable them to stay at their residences peacefully.
7. Hearing of this matter stands adjourned.
8. List the matter under the heading “*New Motion – I*” on 30th September, 2026.
