1. None appears for the petitioner.
2. Alleged contemnors are presented.
3. Learned advocate appearing for the alleged contemnor submits that, in a public interest litigation being WPA(P) 13 of 2024, an investigation into the affairs of the municipality was directed. He submits that, Criminal Investigation Department submitted a report which speaks of huge scam. He submits that, due to pendency of the present contempt petition, appropriate steps could not be taken by the municipality.
4. Municipality is at liberty to take appropriate steps, if criminal liabilities are found on the basis of the report or otherwise, as against the persons involved. Pendency of the contempt petition should not be construed to be a bar in that regard.
