1. This revisional application has been filed challenging the impugned order and judgement dated 5th July, 2025 passed by the learned Additional District and Sessions Judge, 2nd Court, Tamluk, Purba Medinipur affirming the judgement passed by the learned magistrate in connection with the application filed under Section 12 of the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005.
2. Heard the submission of the learned advocate of the petitioner. He is aggrieved so far the quantum of maintenance granted of Rs. 4,000/- (Rs.2,000/- for the wife and Rs. 2,000/- for the minor child) as his income is Rs.6,000/-.
3. The suit for restitution of conjugal life is pending.
4. In view of the above, it appears that petitioner has made out an arguable case for which matter is required to be heard.
5. Hence petitioner is directed to issue notice upon the opposite party
6. Meantime, let there be stay of all further proceedings till 2nd March, 2026 or until further orders, whichever is earlier.

7. Let the matter be listed before regular Bench under the heading 'Contested Application' four weeks hence.

8. Petitioner is directed to pay maintenance of Rs. 3,000/- starting from January, 2026 at present (Rs. 1,500/- for wife and Rs. 1,500/- for minor child) until further orders whichever is earlier. It is pertinent to mention herein in default to pay said amount within 7th day of succeeding month, the order of stay will automatically stand vacated.
