- 1.** Affidavit of compliance filed by the alleged contemnor be taken on record.
- 2.** The petitioner has also filed an exception to such affidavit of compliance. Let it be taken on record.
- 3.** The contention of the alleged contemnor that in view of the direction contained in the order dated 01.08.2017, the subsequent incumbent issued notice upon the petitioner on 07.12.2023, but in spite of receipt of notice none appears on behalf of the petitioner on the appointed date.

4. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner has submitted that no notice dated 07.12.2023 was received by the petitioner and accordingly the petitioner remained absent on the alleged appointed day.

5. It appears from the record that although the alleged contemnor has submitted the copy of the notice dated 07.12.2023 along with postal receipt, but no a/d-card was submitted showing that the petitioner received the notice.

6. Therefore, I find merits in the submissions of the learned counsel of the petitioner. However, on consent of both the parties, let a fresh action be taken in terms of the order dated 01.8.2017. Accordingly, I direct the petitioner to appear before the concerned officer of the alleged contemnor on 15.06.2026 at 2.00 p.m. along with their learned counsel.

7. It is made clear that a notice is not required to be served and this order shall be treated as due notice to the petitioner as well as the alleged contemnor. It is also made clear that if the concerned officer thinks it fit that the respondent nos. 8 and 9 are required to be heard they can issue notices and fix a date in consultation with the learned counsel of the petitioner. The learned counsel for the alleged contemnor has submitted before me that no

inconvenience will be caused to any of the parties or their learned counsel during the hearing on 15.06.2026.

8. List the matter one again on 26th June, 2026.
