1. This is an application for extension of interim order.
2. Mr. Saptarshi Roy, learned counsel appears for the petitioner.
3. None appears for the respondents/Union of India despite notice has been served upon the learned Advocate appearing for the Union of India.
4. The petitioner seeks extension of the interim order dated August 12, 2025 which was extended by the learned co-ordinate Bench vide order dated 15.9.2025 till 7.11.2025.
