1. Heard the learned Counsels for both the parties.
2. The learned Counsel for the petitioner prays for extension of the interim order which is due to expire on 31st December, 2025.
3. The learned Counsel for the respondent vehemently opposes and submits that already the appeal has been filed challenging an order dated 12th August, 2025.
4. In the earlier order dated 04.11.2025 it has already been directed that interim order shall be extended subject to the outcome of the appeal preferred, if any.
5. Let the interim order be extended till 15th February, 2026 or until further order whichever is earlier.

6. The matter to appear in the Combined Monthly List of February, 2026.
7. In the meantime, the respondent is also directed to comply the order dated 04.11.2025 by filing the affidavit-in-opposition within a period of three weeks and reply, if any, two weeks thereafter, failing which the affidavit-in-opposition shall stands forfeited.
