1. We find from the order dated April 2 of 2026 that an adjournment was sought on behalf of the appellants on the said date.
2. We had made it clear that in the event further accommodation was sought by the appellants or the appellants failed to appear on the next date, *ex parte* orders might be passed in the absence of the appellants.
3. Today, at the time of call, none appears for the appellants, nor is any accommodation prayed for on their behalf.
4. Accordingly, MAT No. 1294 of 2025 along with CAN 1 of 2025 are dismissed for default, without any order as to costs.
