Mr. Kaushik Gupta, learned advocate appearing for the
petitioners submits that some more time is required by the
petitioners for furnishing the bank guarantee as directed in the
earlier order dated 17.05.2022.

The petitioners are directed to take steps for furnishing
such bank guarantee by 12th July, 2022.

Let the revisional application appear under the same
heading on 14th July, 2022.

In the meantime, the petitioner nos.1 to 3 would once a
week attend the court of the learned Metropolitan Magistrate, 16th
Court, Calcutta and obtain an acknowledgement regarding their

appearance. So far as the petitioner no.4 is concerned, the authorised representative/advocate would appear and obtain an acknowledgement. The petitioner no.4 would produce all medical documents before the learned Metropolitan Magistrate, 16th Court, Calcutta and the learned Metropolitan Magistrate on being satisfied would allow her to be represented through a learned advocate once a week. The learned Magistrate would consider her physical appearance after exercising his/her discretion regarding her medical fitness.

The interim order earlier granted is extended till 18th July, 2022.

The Investigating Officer of the case is present. Her appearance before this Court for the day is dispensed with. However, she is directed to be present on the next date fixed for hearing.

All parties shall act on the server copy of this order duly downloaded from the official website of this Court.
