At the inception Mr. Kaushik Gupta, learned advocate appearing for the petitioners draws the attention of this Court to the order dated 04.01.2022 passed by the learned District Judge I/C at Alipore wherein it has been ordered as follows :

“Opposite party is hereby restrained from taking forceful custody of her three children namely 1) Shabra Yusuf, 2) Huzaaz Yusuf, 3) Almass Yusuf from the custody of the present petitioner without due process of law till 04.02.2022.”

Affidavit-in-opposition filed by the opposite party and affidavit-in-reply filed by the petitioners be kept with the record.

Report submitted by Mr. Kallol Mondal, learned Mediator be kept in a closed envelope along with the records.

On perusal of the order passed by the learned District Judge, I am of the opinion that there would be no deviation from the order, if this Court directs the opposite party viz., Isra Bano to visit her three children between 5 p.m. to 7 p.m. on Wednesdays and Saturdays in each and every week at 67A, Diamond Harbour Road, Khidirpore, Ekbalpur-police station, Kolkata-700023.

At the time of such visitation, Mr. Aniruddha Bhattacharyya, learned advocate for the opposite party would be present along with the opposite party and Ms. Aparna Basu Chowdhury, learned advocate for the petitioners would also be present at the address mentioned above.

Both the learned advocates, so present, would submit their reports which would be on each and every day's findings after a period of two months when the matter would appear in the list.

Interim order, earlier granted, is extended till 19.04.2022.

List this matter under the heading "For Orders" on 12.04.2022.

All parties shall act on the server copy of this order duly downloaded from the official *website* of this Court.

Urgent photostat certified copy of this order, if applied for, be supplied to the parties upon compliance with all requisite formalities.
