The issue that arises for consideration is whether the second proviso to Section 18(1) of the SARFAESI Act, 2002 shall apply in case of an appeal arising out of an order passed on an interlocutory application refusing to direct the bank to implement the circular towards one time settlement.

By the order impugned, the learned Debts Recovery Appellate Tribunal directed the petitioner to make a pre-deposit of 50% of Rs.4.95 crores.

Petitioner is directed to serve a copy of this application along with the supplementary affidavit upon the opposite parties by registered speed post with acknowledgement due and file an affidavit of service on the next date.
