**Gopal Maity & Ors.
Vs.
State of West Bengal & Anr.**

1. This revisional application is filed by the present petitioners being an octogenarian father-in-law and the mother-in-law aged about 67 years and the sister-in-law and her husband against an order dated 23rd May, 2025 fixing the date for framing of charge.
2. It is submitted by the learned advocate representing the petitioners that the petitioners are parents-in-law and the sister-in-law and are nowhere connected with the said complaint and they have been implicated in the said complaint alleging false and frivolous allegations.
3. It is further submitted that the FIR itself would reveal that there is no such incriminating material or allegation or overt act levelled against any of the present petitioners. It is further submitted that a compromise settlement was entered into between the parties and an amount of Rs. 2,50,000/- was the total claim by the de facto complainant and out of which Rs. 1,00,000/- has been

paid. Despite that, the de facto complainant has not taken any step to withdraw the complaint and under compelling circumstances, the present petitioners have come up before this Court.

4. Heard the submissions, perused the record, contents of the FIR and the nature of allegations levelled against the present petitioners, which, primarily, do not attract any ingredient in respect of the charge framed against them by filing the charge-sheet.
5. In view of the above, the matter is required to be heard.
6. Accordingly, petitioners are directed to serve the copy of the criminal revisional application alongwith all annexures upon the opposite party no.1/State through the office of the learned Public Prosecutor, High Court, Calcutta and upon the opposite party no.2 through Speed Post with acknowledgement due and file affidavit of service on the next date of hearing.
7. In the meantime, let there be stay of all further proceedings in BGR 1417 of 2017 (Gosaba 55/17) pending before the Court of learned 7th Judicial Magistrate, Alipore, South 24 Parganas till 30th November, 2025.
8. Let the matter be listed in the monthly list of November, 2025 before the regular Bench.
