1. All the learned counsel appearing on behalf of the parties to this revisional application are present.
2. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the opposite party no.2 has submitted that liberty was given to the petitioner to amend the cause title at once as name of the victim appeared in the cause title. But the name of the victim has been suppressed in the body of the revisional application according to the notification No.3960-G dated 25th September, 2023.
3. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the opposite party No.2 has further submitted that correction was made in violation of the order of this Court.
4. According to the order of Hon'ble Division Bench in

connection with C.R.A. (DB) 29 of 2022, notification No. 3960-G dated 25th September, 2023 was published, whereby some practice directions were embedded, thereby directing not to disclose the identity of the victim or her family in any documents or applications filed before the Court.

5. In these circumstances, I do not find any reason to consider the submission advanced on behalf of the opposite party no.2 and direct the petitioner to withdraw this revisional application.
6. Learned concerned Registrar is directed to do the needful in compliance with the notification No. 3960-G dated 25th September, 2023.
