1. Despite service, none appears for the respondent at the time of call. The affidavit-of-service filed today be kept on record.
2. The present application has been filed for extension of time to deposit the decretal amount as condition for grant of stay, as directed by a coordinate Bench on April 03, 2024 in connection with the present appeal.
3. Upon perusal of the explanation given in the application regarding inter-departmental red-tapism, we are convinced that credible and sufficient cause for the delay has been shown in making the deposit.
4. Accordingly, CAN 3 of 2024 is allowed, thereby extending the time for deposit of the decretal amount in terms of the order dated April 03, 2024 till January 03, 2025.
5. It is made clear that in the event such deposit is made within the said time-limit, it will be deemed that it is in compliance with the order dated April 03, 2024. However,

in the event of default in such payment, the stay order granted earlier shall stand automatically vacated.

6. There will be no order as to costs.
