A plain reading of the complaint does not disclose any intention on the part of the petitioners to deceive the complainant from the inception. On the contrary, the complaint itself acknowledges that the petitioners had delivered cement worth Rs. 6,93,400/- out of the total value of Rs. 7,84,800/-.

In view of the aforesaid, there shall be a stay of all further proceedings in C. No. 158 of 2023 under Sections 420/406/504/506/323/120B/34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, initiated on the basis of an application filed under Section 156(3) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, which was subsequently treated as a complaint under Section 200 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, and pending before the learned Judicial Magistrate, 8th Court, Alipore, 24 Parganas (South), for a period of six months from date.

List this matter in the combined monthly list of January, 2027 under the heading "Contested Application".

Let a copy of the application be served upon the opposite parties, with an intimation that the matter shall be listed in the Combined Monthly List of January, 2027, under the heading "Contested Application".
